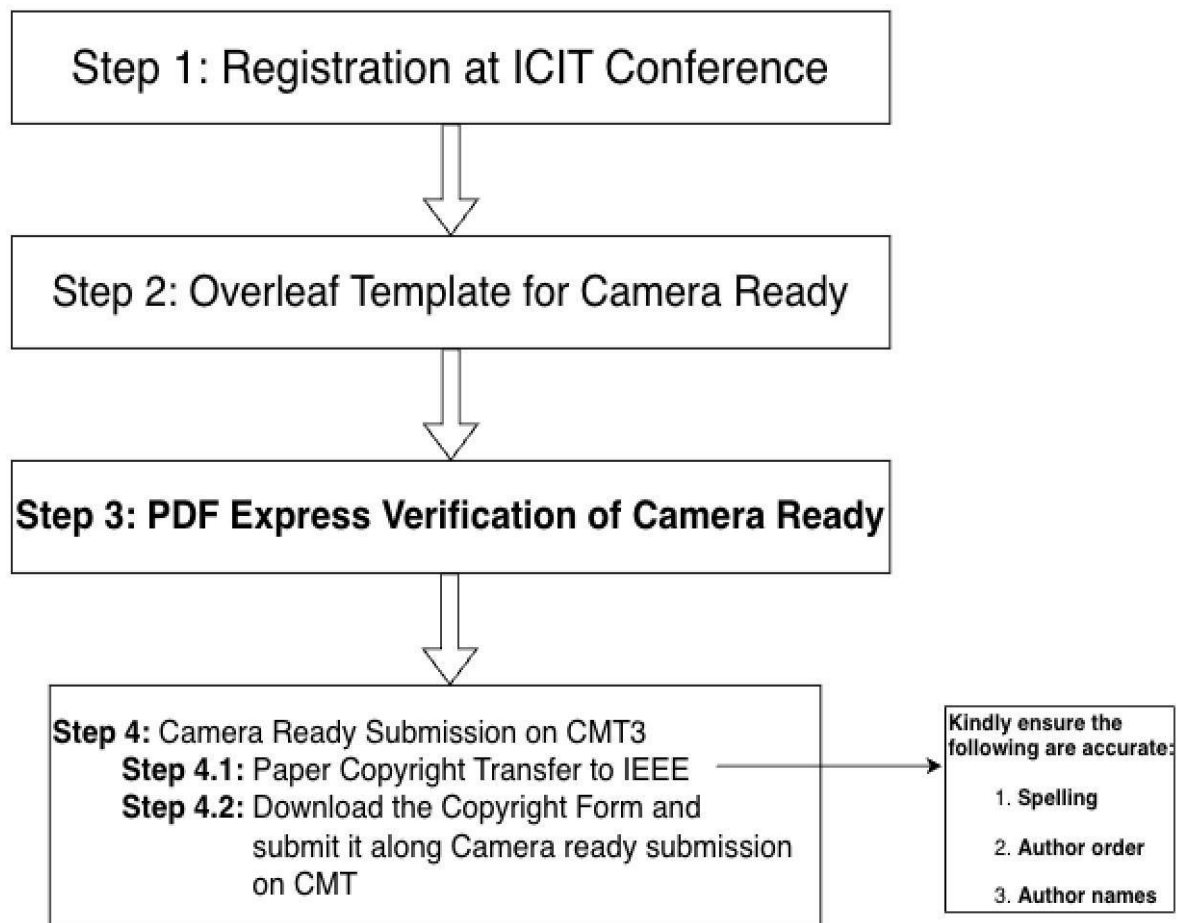


Dear authors,

On behalf of ICIT organizing committee, we congratulate you on getting your papers accepted at this prestigious conference. For the final camera-ready version, please ensure that the following instructions are followed.

Details of each step is provided below:

## Camera Ready Timeline and Steps for ICIT 2026



## 1. Registration (Deadline: **Monday, March 02, 2026**)

- a. [Registration Portal \(Click here\)](#)- Follow the steps to complete the registration.
- b. In case of failure to meet the deadline, the status of the submission will be considered as **WITHDRAWN** from publishing in ICIT conference as *“IEEE reserves the right to exclude a paper from distribution after the conference, including IEEE Xplore® Digital Library, if the paper is not presented by the author at the conference.”*
- c. Timely registration will help us to proceed with copyrights and further planning for the conference.

## 2. Camera-Ready Submission on Overleaf

- a. Login your CMT3 for reviewers’ comments to incorporate them for final submission. You will be provided an Overleaf (LaTeX) Project Repository Link to prepare the final camera-ready submission. LaTeX template is mandatory for camera-ready submission with source code to track the paper in the proceedings of ICIT 2026.
- b. Please make the necessary changes pointed out by the reviewers, to improve the quality of your work even further.
- c. **Please note that the maximum allowed plagiarism (with citations) is 30% on IEEE Cross Check tool. Note that the paper may still be rejected by IEEE if the similarity index is not below the mentioned percentage. The conference will not be responsible for paper getting rejected due to this problem.**
- d. Ensure that you are modifying the following paper template (Latex) in order to comply with IEEE Explorer requirements. **Do not duplicate or submit another copy of source files, please.** This link is specifically generated for your submission and will be used as source file for IEEE submission. This link will also be used by ICIT Secretariat for tracking of your camera-ready submission.

Overleaf template is shared on authors’ mail addresses.

- d. Make sure not to remove the copyright notice at the bottom of the first page of your source document. **(979-8-3315-5017-2/26/\$31.00 ©2026 IEEE)**. This is already available in your overleaf project, kindly **do not change or replace it**.
- e. Make sure not to remove the title of the conference mentioned at the top center of the source document. **(2026 International Conference on IT and Industrial Technologies (ICIT))**
- f. If your paper exceeds a length of 6 pages (including abstract, introduction, literature review, figures, and references), then an additional charge per page will apply on your paper.
- g. Proofread your source document thoroughly to confirm that it will require no revision.

h. **Make sure and finalize the authors list for any order change, spelling mistakes, and affiliation. After this step neither ICIT, nor IEEE will respond to any query for author list change.**

### 3. Copyright Form (eCF) Transfer (Deadline: **Friday, March 13, 2026**)

a. After successful submission on CMT3, an IEEE eCF form will be required by IEEE. The form is available on your author console. You are required to complete the copyright process of IEEE for the inclusion of your paper in IEEE publication. After filling the form on IEEE site, download the copy of form and submit it on CMT as well.

## IEEE Publication Agreement



### Welcome

➤ **The following steps will lead you through the process of either transferring copyright or licensing publishing rights to IEEE.**

STEP 1: Confirm article information.

STEP 2: Confirm article originality, signing authority and funder.

STEP 3: Select the appropriate publishing agreement.

STEP 4: Sign the publication agreement.

STEP 5: Download the signed publication agreement.

b. **Make sure you write correct names with correct affiliations matching on your camera-ready submission. Any mismatch or discrepancies in author names and affiliations will result to paper exclusion from conference proceedings on IEEE Xplore.**
